| POSITION TITLE: | Vice President |
| :--- | :--- |
| PURPOSE: | The Vice President is the second executive officer of the <br> chapter. This position replaces the President when necessary <br> at meetings of the Executive Committee, the Chapter and the <br> CSUEU Board of Directors. The President may also assign <br> the Vice President to assist him/her in other administrative <br> tasks. |
| TYPICAL DUTIES: | In the absence of the President, chairs Executive Committee <br> and Chapter meetings and attends CSUEU Board of Directors <br> meetings as board member. |
| TIME COMMITMENT: | Executive Committee meetings - One hour per month. <br> Other time commitments depend on direct involvement in <br> committees or programs (optional). |
| TRAINING: | Basic Steward Training |
| REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS: | Reports to the President. <br> Reports to the Chapter Executive Committee. |
| RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER | The Vice President is primarily an administrative and <br> coordinating position in the absence of or at the direction of <br> the President. |
| EFFICERS/PROGRAMS: | The Vice President is elected by chapter members to a three- <br> year term. |
