



## Officer Descriptions and Eligibility

<b>Chapter Office</b>	<b>Eligibility Requirement</b>
<b>President</b>	Subject to the overall control of the Board of Directors, the President shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation, and shall supervise, direct and manage the Corporation's activities, affairs and other officers.
<b>Vice President for Organizing</b>	The Vice President for Organizing is the second officer of the Corporation and shall have the primary responsibility to develop and implement all organizing and recruitment activities of the Corporation.
<b>Vice President for Finance</b>	The Vice President for Finance is the chief financial officer of the CSUEU, and the third executive officer of the Corporation.
<b>Vice President for Representation</b>	The Vice-President for Representation is the fourth executive officer of the Corporation and is responsible for the coordination, training, development, and operations of the Corporation's representation program.

### Prohibited Conduct

*The following conduct is prohibited for all candidates and members during the elections process. Protest procedures are available at the CSUEU Elections website at <http://www.csueu.org>*

- Candidates and members are prohibited from using obscene and/or false statements.
- Candidates and members shall not encourage voters to base their judgments on considerations of race, color, sex, religion, occupation, national origin, sexual orientation, ancestry, disability, age or any legally protected class.
- Members' dues shall not be used to support or oppose any candidate for any CSUEU office.
- CSUEU equipment or resources such as, but not limited to, telephones, fax machines and computers shall not be used for the purpose of supporting or opposing any candidate over another for any CSUEU office.
- CSEA staff are prohibited from advocating for or against candidates or rendering any services to any candidate for any CSUEU office.

### Oath of Office
