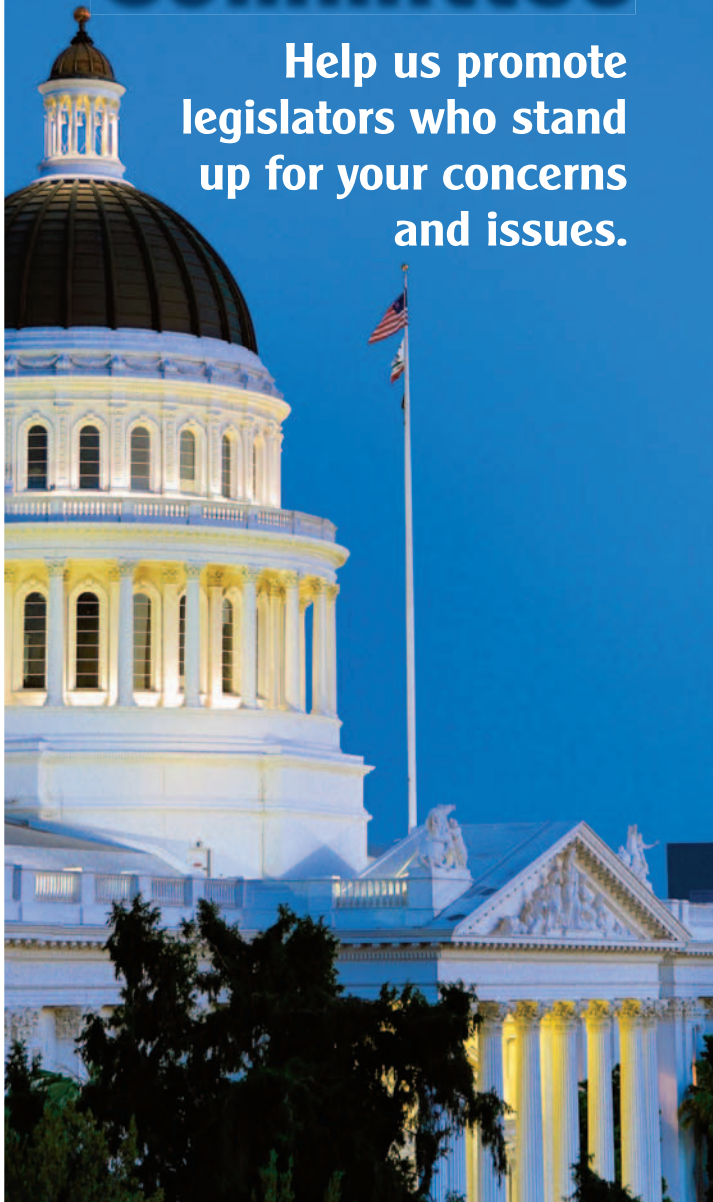

CSUEU has a long and colorful history, highlighted by triumphs across some of the most pressing state worker issues of our time. An affiliate of the California State Employees Association, the union incorporated in 2005 and now represents some 14,500 employees on 23 CSU campuses and the Office of the Chancellor. Our bargaining units comprise the majority of non-academic employees across the CSU system.



CSUEU formed its own Political Activities Committee (PAC) in 2009 with the goal of supporting candidates who value CSU employees and who work to defeat measures that threaten our interests. CSUEU needs a strong voice in Sacramento now more than ever.

A PAC is a public, open means of participating in the democratic process. PACs must report how much they raise and how the money is

spent. The CSUEU PAC supports candidates and measures that help the union protect jobs, ensure favorable working conditions, and maintain and enhance wages for its represented members, who provide important services to students throughout the CSU system. Its professional staff and volunteer leaders testify at hearings, meet with legislators, and organize forums to promote CSUEU’s message. With members at 23 CSU campuses and the Office of the Chancellor, the PAC has the potential to strengthen our position in the State Capitol.

The CSUEU PAC gets its strength through the power of its membership.
